PEEBLESSHIRE BEEKEEPERS ASSOCIATION TREASURERS REPORT MARCH 2022

Income this year was £3793.46. Expenditure totalled £2570.78. This gave a profit of £1222.68, and a final cash balance of £3665.10.

After a previous couple of small loss making years the association this year made a healthy profit.

One major purchase of a portable bee vacuum costing \pounds 420 was more than compensated for by a total of \pounds 600 donations, from 2 separate householders, where the equipment was used to remove colonies from their property.

All assets were deemed to have depreciated by 15%, except for bee colonies which retain market value. The current market value of bee colonies is deemed to be £200. The net number of association colonies, after winter losses, is 3. In total, the fixed assets have a net book value of £4575.33

Overall the association holds cash and assets worth £8240.43.

Membership numbers bounced back from only 35 during the temporary suspension in 2021 due to Covid, and have substantially increased from the 2020 figure of 51 to a total of 74 paid up members.

The mini point of sale (POS) device from Square proved useful for market sales. As did the PayPal account which was used as a payment option for subscriptions via the website.

Despite the ongoing situation with Covid restrictions, the association has been able to generate increased funds. The association continues to be in a strong financial position and well able to support the activities of its membership.

As always, suggestions for purchases will be welcomed by the committee.
